DIRECTIONS FROM I-20 (heading west)

I-20 West, take first exit after I-75/I-85 EXIT 55B Lee Street

TURN LEFT, going south on Lee Street

TURN LEFT at 2nd Light, which is Ralph David Abernathy

TURN RIGHT on Metropolitan Parkway

TAKE IMMEDIATE RIGHT into Metropolitan Warehouses

Entrance gate is up ramp on your LEFT

DIRECTIONS FROM I-20 (heading east)

I-20 East, EXIT 55A Lowery Blvd / West End

TURN LEFT onto Oak Street

TURN RIGHT on Lee Street

TURN LEFT on Ralph David Abernathy

TURN RIGHT on Metropolitan Parkway

TAKE IMMEDIATE RIGHT into Metropolitan Warehouses -

Entrance gate is up ramp on your LEFT

ONCE YOU ARE AT THE METROPOLITAN

At the keypad on ramp, enter the gate code 7004* to open the automatic gate.

Once you have gone through the gate, take a sharp right - U-Turn -

At the end of building turn left and we are #6026 on the right
